## 2009 Flu Shot Clinics

Immunizations will be administered by the Will County Health Department in cooperation with the Senior Services Center of Will County. Influenza Vaccine is recommended for all persons who want to reduce their risk of becoming ill with influenza or of transmitting to others. Shots will be given to adults 18 and older. Persons 50 and older, people with chronic medical problems who are at risk of complications to the flu, healthcare personnel, pregnant women, and contacts of those who are at high risk are highly recommended to receive this vaccine.

(Pregnant women **must** have an order from the obstetrician.)

**You must reside in Will County.**

**Please bring your Medicare card, Social security card and a picture I.D. with you.  
The cost is \$25 without your Medicare Card.**

**Notice to HMO Carriers:** You must go to your primary care physician for your HMO to cover the cost of the Flu Vaccine.
