H1N1 CLINICS SET FOR TWO JOLIET CHURCHES

JOLIET – The Will County Health Department (WCHD) is teaming with the National Hook-Up of Black Women, Inc. to cosponsor H1N1 walk-in community clinics at two Joliet churches Sunday, January 10.

All are welcome to clinics scheduled for the Mt. Zion Baptist Church (402 Singleton Place), and the Second Baptist Church (156 South Joliet St.). Both clinics are set for 1-4 p.m.

“The Health Department is excited about the opportunity to collaborate with the Joliet Chapter of the National Hook-Up of Black Women to make this project a reality,” according to WCHD executive director John Cicero. “We want to do all we can to make sure H1N1 vaccine is as widely available as possible throughout the community. The flu season will be with us for at least another three months, and it’s advisable that people who have postponed vaccination so far get immunized against H1N1 soon.”

The National Hook-Up of Black Women, Inc. is a non-profit 501(c) 3 charitable community service organization dedicated to improving the lives of families through support of the arts, culture, health, education, and human services programs. The Joliet Chapter was established in October, 1991.
