


The Will County AOK Network hosts a FREE annual Early Childhood Mental Health Conference.

130 service providers participate in the conference each year - 84% of attendees receive CEU credits.

Partners created a **community calendar** for families to find a free screening for their child, birth to five years old. Over 10,000 children are screened each year in Will County.
