COMPREHENSIVE SERVICES FOR INDIVIDUALS & FAMILIES IMPACTED BY DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

FREE & CONFIDENTIAL SERVICES:

EMERGENCY SHELTER

Our 30 bed shelter provides a temporary safe haven for women and their children who are survivors of domestic violence, 365 days a year.

INDIVIDUAL COUNSELING

Our trained professionals provide one-on-one counseling to adults and children. Survivors explore the impact domestic violence has had on their lives in a supportive environment while safety planning, healing, and defining goals to self-empowerment.

GROUP COUNSELING

Together with others who share the pain of domestic violence, victims become survivors in talking about their experiences and realizing that they are not alone. Led by a trained professional counselor, group participants have

the opportunity to learn new life skills and regain their sense of self-esteem and well-being. Groups are offered several times throughout the week for both women and children.



Legal advocates, while not lawyers, assist survivors of domestic violence in obtaining orders of protection, pressing criminal charges, and navigating the court system. Trained medical advocates are available 24/7, 365 days per year to provide crisis intervention services to survivors in emergency rooms. Advocates provide information and emotional support to help survivors make informed choices and regain a sense of control over their lives.

SUPPORT GROUPS & COMMUNITY PRESENTATIONS

Support groups for adult survivors of domestic violence are offered at several locations throughout the community. Also, members of our trained professional staff are available to give educational presentations to churches, community groups and other organizations.

PRESENTATIONS & TRAINING

Our presentations and trainings offer social service, law enforcement, education professionals, and volunteers valuable resources, and information regarding of domestic violence.
