Birth Control & Contraception

It can be overwhelming when you have a lot of options available but we are here to help! We offer:

- Free condoms
- Male and female physical assessments
- Abstinence and safe sex education
- Education on birth control methods
- Hormonal and non-hormonal contraception and emergency contraception

Sexually Transmitted Infections

Most STIs are asymptomatic, meaning you may have no symptoms at all. Which is why you should get tested regularly if you are sexually active. Come in for confidential:

- Testing
- Treatment
- HIV counseling
- Education

CONFIDENTIALITY

Everything you discuss with the clinic staff will be kept private. In 2019, 45% of IL teens did not use a condom the last time they engaged in sex

CONSENT

By law, persons age 12 and older can give consent to receive sexual health services in the state of Illinois.

TRUST

Teen years can be a confusing time, but you are not alone. Trust us to help you with all the questions you may have during this time. In 2020, there were 213 live births among teens in Will County
