Preventing, Reporting, Responding, and Managing Measles in Schools and Daycares March 21, 2024 Begins at Noon

Thus far in 2024, the CDC has already confirmed 45 cases of measles in the U.S., compared to 58 cases for all of 2023. Illinois has had 13 cases of measles in the last six months, after not reporting any cases in the prior three years. This is reflective of a rise in global measles cases and a growing global threat from the disease.


This one-hour virtual event is free to School Nurses, Daycare Providers and other School Health clinicians.
