EMERGENCY CARE - Many injuries or illnesses are frightening, but not true emergencies. The hospital emergency room should only be used in severe life-threatening situations. Responding quickly and remaining calm is difficult in emergent times.

REMEMBER your Doctor is available 24 hours a day and only a telephone call away. Always telephone the Health Center prior to using the Emergency Room, unless it is an extremely severe condition.

To make the most out of your appointment: - Arrive 15 minutes early. - Bring medication bottles and anything else you want to discuss. - Bring your photo ID, insurance card or proof of income (acceptable proof of income: pay stubs, tax forms, letter from employer, or other documents verifying amount of income).

It is important to your health keep all appointments.

If you cannot make your appointment, please call as soon as possible to reschedule. Please call if you are going to be late for your appointment. You may be asked to reschedule or see another provider.

Tell us about other health care professionals who care for you.

Keep us informed about your medical history, current medications, ER visits, recent test results to ensure safer care and better health outcomes.

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Primary Care Services

As Your Medical Home we can help you manage your total health care, as well as your cultural & language needs. Our highly trained & compassionate nurses & staff members work closely with our doctors, dentists and managers to provide a quality experience for patients needing services.

- **Family and Internal Medicine** - Physical exams, diagnosis, and sick visits are provided to adults as well as children. Also pre-employment physical exams & immigration physicals.
- **Pediatrics** - Physical exams, including well baby exams, school exams, sick visits, immunizations, medical diagnosis, and treatment for all illnesses for children.
- **Family Planning** - Medical exams, pregnancy tests, lab tests, counseling, women's health education, and family planning methods are provided to meet your individual needs.
- **Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STD)** - Counseling, testing, treatment, and follow-up care. Anonymous and confidential HIV/AIDS testing is available as well as pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) for persons at high risk for HIV.
- **Behavioral Health Services** - Psychiatry and Counseling including medication, individual and group counseling, and substance use disorder treatment, including vivitrol and suboxone.
- **Women's Services** - Prenatal care for every stage of pregnancy. Extensive birth control to fit your lifestyle. Management of heavy bleeding and painful cycles. Provides routine female health maintenance with breast and cervical cancer screening.
- **Affordable Care Act/Insurance** - Eligibility counselors available for assistance with Medicaid, and Marketplace insurance enrollment.
- **Medication Assisted Treatment(MAT)** - Treatment for Substance Abuse Disorders centering around Opioids and Alcohol. This is achieved with the use of Vivitrol (Naltrexone) and Suboxone. (Buprenorphine and Naloxone) as part of a comprehensive program.

Fees, Payments & Health Insurance

As a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC), Will County Community Health Center offer discounts based on federally established guidelines.

Discounts are based upon family size and income.

Proof of income is required to be considered for a discount. There is a nominal \$25.00 fee due per visit, for medical, \$50 for dental. No one is turned away for inability to pay.

Most Laboratory services for self-pay patients ordered and processed at the clinic are eligible for discounts and are billed by the centers' contracted vendors.

This Health Center is a Health Center Program grantee under 42 U.S.C. 245b, & a deemed FTCA Public Health Service employee under 42 U.S.C. 233(g)-(n).

- We accept Medicaid, Medicare, private insurance, some HMO's and PPO's.
- MasterCard & Visa may also be used.
- No insurance? You may be eligible for a discount (based on family size & income).
